



## PRACTICE FLUENCY WITH ACCURACY ACTIVITIES

### SAMPLE SENTENCES

1. The cat sat on the mat.
2. Sam will pack a small bag.
3. The sun set and the sky got pink.

### 1. WORD-BY-WORD TOUCH AND READ

Students point to each word in the sentence and read slowly and accurately, one word at a time. This reinforces grapheme to phoneme mapping and reduces guessing.

### 2. FIND AND READ TARGET WORDS

Ask students to find a word in sentence 2 that has the short /ă/ sound. Students locate words like "Sam", "pack", and "bag". Students read each chosen word, then read the full sentence. This reinforces accurate decoding of phonics patterns.

### 3. PHRASE SCOOP AND READ

Provide scooped phrases for sentence 3: "the sun" / "set and" / "the sky" / "got pink." Students trace scoops in the air and read each phrase accurately, then read the full sentence. This supports accuracy and meaningful phrasing.
